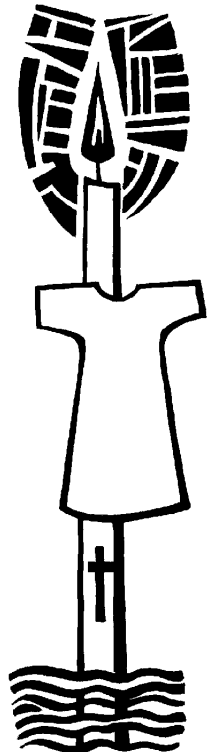

Dear Parents

Your child must be at least 8 years old or in Year 3 or higher in school to start the preparation for First Communion.

Thank you for your effort to be faithful to the baptism promises you made on behalf of your child. Helping your child to prepare for First Communion and Reconciliation is a very important step in your child's faith journey.

It is essential for your child to have your support at this very blessed time. So please be involved as much as possible. Go through each chapter of the child's book — 'I Belong' and help broaden your child's knowledge. Also remember to pray with your child as a family.

The sessions at Sacred Heart's Parish Hall take place on Saturday, at 9:30 - 11:00am. There will be special meetings for parents and at least one parent must come. You will receive a time-table of children's and parents' meetings. Children and parents are expected to come every Sunday to Mass during the year of the preparation, not only when there are lessons.

There will not be any sessions during holiday time. **Do not arrange holidays at any of the fixed dates for the sessions.** We all appreciate the work of our Catechists. Children should be collected from the Parish House, after each sessions.

If a parent is not a Catholic, they are most welcome to participate as much as they can, or wish. If they would like to know more about First Holy Communion, or the Catholic faith, they are very welcome to come and have a chat with your Parish Priest, Fr. Gideon Wagay.
