MESSAGE FROM CARDINAL NICHOLS

"Well, this lockdown has to go on and we have to be persistent and resilient and keep up the effort that we're making in order to protect each other- protect other people. But there's a big thank you I want to give to all those who are caring for others. It's especially true in our care homes, in our hospitals, but it's true in every place where somebody is genuinely caring for another person. And in these circumstances, it's stressful, but it's deeply appreciated. And we can see on a Thursday evening how much that caring work, especially in the NHS and in care homes, is appreciated. Now, what we want to do, is add to that public applause, the practice of public prayer. So, every Thursday at 7:00 pm, a bishop will celebrate Mass in one of the cathedrals, for the care of the workers – 7:00pm every Thursday. We will begin here at Westminster Cathedral. And even more importantly, use that time before 8:00pm on a Thursday to offer your prayers of thanksgiving for these generous, courageous people, for their support- their encouragement – that God will sustain them in this great work that they're doing. We applaud, but we pray fervently for them. May God bless them all."
