Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I am happy to announce that Masses will resume at our church starting this weekend. This is long-awaited and very good news. Unfortunately, to be able to open the church, it is my responsibility that certain measures are in place including clearly marked social distancing, one way system of movement around the church and regular cleaning of the church. I realize that it may take a while for people to feel confident enough to come back to church, so you will be pleased to know that the bishops have decreed that for the moment the Sunday obligation does not apply. We encourage the older parishioners and those who are vulnerable to come to Mass during the week when there are less people present. Please be aware that for the moment we are not yet returning to the pattern of worship that we are used to, we are to keep the celebration of the Mass brief, but dignified. We hope that the following guidance will help to clarify our new patterns of practice (read further at the back of the newsletter for the Government and Diocesan advice). RE-OPENING OF THE CHURCH FOR PUBLIC LITURGY

It is vitally important that we all remember that we are not returning to how things were before lockdown. The COVID-19 virus is very much still around. We are still living with the pandemic. Needless to say, if you are sick or if you have an underlying condition, please do not come to church yet. While Catholics have an obligation to attend Sunday Mass every week, this obligation **remains suspended** by the Bishops during this pandemic.

There are a few things to do for those who will be attending Mass:

- You must wear face mask.
- There will be one entrance and one exit. Please follow the ushers instructions at all times.
- Please gel your hands at the entrance. The usher will direct you to your seat, probably not the usual one that you sit in. Please do not give them grief over this! Be understanding.
- Holy Communion will be under one kind only and in the hand. Approach the priest for Communion still with your mask on.
- You must keep social distancing at all times, on entry, at Communion time and at the end of Mass.
- There will be a Collection. We still have not figure out how to do this, but maybe as you come in by putting your donation in a box by the foot of the altar or at the back of church.
- Masses will be at usual times during the week at 9:15.
- Sunday Masses will be Sat. 6:00pm, 8:30 and 11:00 am.
- Confessions on Saturday 11:00 – 12:00 Noon.
- For those who cannot come on a Sunday, maybe come on a weekday Mass at 9:15.
- Please do not congregate outside of the church after Mass.
- Toilet are not available yet.

Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel Matthew 11:25-30

1. For Jesus, the key to a personal knowledge of God and relationship with God is not primarily through academic study but through a mind and heart open to learn. Recall moments when you had a sense that your relationship with God took a significant step forward. What kind of dispositions prepared you for that growth? 2. Jesus lived in a society in which people were very conscious of status, dignity and external appearances. He wanted to break down the barriers this created, so that all would be aware of their worth and dignity. Perhaps you can recall someone who was not highly thought of in human terms, but who was a light to you.

3. In v. 27, Jesus lets us into the secret of his relationship with his Father, one of total trust. This trust freed him from anxiety and worry about himself. As a result, he was a person of gentle and humble heart and was able to bring rest to those who were overburdened. Recall people whose trust in God enabled them to be supportive to others who were stressed or burdened. Perhaps you have experienced this yourself?

4. Recall and give thanks for people who, like Jesus in the story, were able to combine challenge with sympathetic support and understanding. Perhaps you have been able to do this for others at times also.
