These can now be obtained directly from the local Registrar in the Town Hall.

BAPTISM

Babies are usually baptised in the first 6 months after birth. To book a baptism for your child, please contact the parish office. At least one parent of the child and the godparent must supply us with their Catholic baptismal certificate and the child's birth certificate.
