The Parish Foodbank update

Our Foodbank has been in operation now for 30 months. Up until March 31 this year we registered 435 families with 883 adults and 728 children, and provided them their choice of non-perishable foods, toiletries and cleaning materials. In 2022, your extremely generous donations amounted to £8,430, and we received a grant from the Cardinal's Lenten Appeal of £11.014. Together with money left over at the end of 2021, we were able to buy and give out £21,700 worth of supplies. Demand has risen steeply in 2023, and we have received further support from the Cripplegate Foundation/Islington Giving and the Arsenal Foundation Small Awards scheme, but matching demand with supply remains a challenge. Once again, your donations in cash or in kind will be gratefully received.
