I was later assigned to be Secondary School Chaplain. I served in this ministry for nine years, in three big Diocesan schools.

In March 2023 the Zambia Conference of Catholic Bishops assigned me to the UK-Zambian Catholic Chaplaincy. I am happy to be in Sacred Heart Parish as I take up my new assignment.
