SACRAMENTS

These can now be obtained directly from the local Registrar in the Town Hall.

BAPTISM

Babies are usually baptised in the first 6 months after birth. To book a baptism for your child, please contact the parish office. Parents of the child must practice their faith and registered members of the parish. At least one parent of the child and the godparent must supply us with their Catholic baptismal certificate and the child's birth certificate. Pilgrimage to Walsingham

We're delighted so many people are interested in the forthcoming Westminster Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham - Theme: 'Mary, Mother of the Home'. Here are the details:

Date: 23rd September 2023

Meeting time: 7:30 am

Return time: Approx. 8:00 pm

Cost: £35 per person/ £25 Children under 12. (includes coach and Pilgrims' Levy Fee.)

To secure the coach, company has requested a deposit, and we can only commit to the hire if you secure your place by making the payment in advance. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Please bring the £35 in cash by this weekend (2-3 September). There will be someone collecting the money after each Mass. Alternatively, you can bring the money to the office during office hours.

Driving to Sacred Heart Catholic Church -

Introducing a trial traffic filter by Islington Council from **Monday, 25 September 2023.**

As part of the next phase of works, we are introducing a traffic filter as an 18-month trial. This will help reduce traffic outside the school gate and will make it easier to walk, wheel or cycle. Traffic filters are restrictions in the street to prevent motor vehicles passing through.

Camera enforcement is used to allow emergency vehicles to continue to access the area. Non-exempt vehicles driving through the filter will be identified by camera and issued a penalty charge notice of £65.00.

All addresses on the School Street will remain accessible by vehicle following the implementation of the traffic filter, but the route you take may change.

Blue Badge holders living north of Mackenzie Road, to Caledonian Road to the west, Holloway Road to the east, and Hornsey Street to the north will automatically be exempt from the traffic filter.

You can email us at pfsbluebadge@islington.gov.uk if you are a Blue Badge holder in the defined area and have not received a letter notifying you of your exemption by Monday, 4 September.

The filter will reduce through-traffic in the area, creating safer, quieter and cleaner streets around Sacred Heart Primary School.

Vehicles can access all addresses on Georges Road and Eden Grove from Holloway Road. Vehicles will also be able to access all addresses on Lough Road and to drive to Piper Close and Watkinson Road via Lough Road. However, vehicles will not be able to drive from Georges Road to MacKenzie Road via Lough Road or from Lough Road into Eden Grove. We are not making changes to the direction of traffic.

CONTACTLESS GIVING

We have **two machines**, at the entrance and by the baptismal font near St Peter's statue. This donation method has proved to be easy and safe, and it is practical, as we don't normally carry cash nowadays.
