Sacraments

Marriage Preparation - If you are planning to marry here or elsewhere, at least 6 months notice is required and you MUST contact a priest to register for a preparation course, via email. We're not able to issue civil marriage certificate for marriages that took place in our church.

Baptism - Usually happens in the first 6 months after birth. Parents must practice their faith and be registered members of the parish. The next parents and godparents preparation meeting will be in the winter. Date TBC, Please contact the parish office for more details.

First Holy Communion – Programme - 2023-2024

The first parents/carers meetings will be on Tuesday 7th October at 7:00 pm in the parish hall. First session for the children is on Saturday 11th November at 9:30 am.

We are looking forward to working with the children and their families.

RCIA - A journey in faith - The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a programme that we run in the Parish every year. It is an invitation to people who might want to explore the possibility of becoming a Roman Catholic as well as a refresher course for those who are already baptised but did not complete the Sacraments of Initiation, i.e. Eucharist and Confirmation. Sometimes people like to attend the RCIA to find out more about the faith they were baptised into and they see it as an opportunity to go deeper and explore the riches of the Catholic tradition. **The programme will be starting in October**, contact our parish office for more details.
