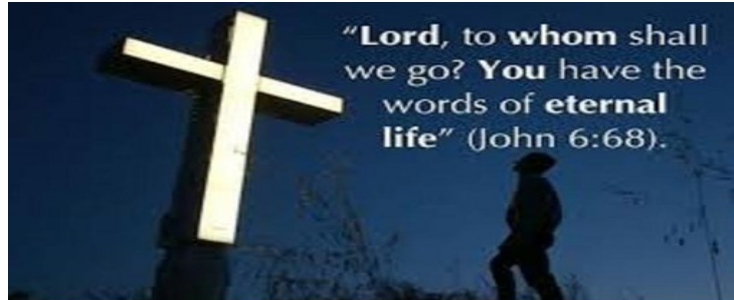

The sacred dignity of the Eucharistic ministry Part I

Celebration of the Eucharist places before us many other requirements regarding the ministry of the Eucharistic table. Some of these requirements concern only priests and deacons, others concern all who participate in the Eucharistic Liturgy. Priests and deacons must remember that the service of the table of the Bread of the Lord imposes on them special obligations which refer in the first place to Christ Himself present in the Eucharist and secondly to all who actually participate in the Eucharist or who might do so. With regard to the first, perhaps it will not be superfluous to recall the words of the Pontifical which on the day of ordination the bishop addresses to the new priest as he hands to him on the paten and in the chalice the bread and wine offered by the faithful and prepared by the deacon: "Accept from the Holy people of God the gifts to be offered to Him. Know what you are doing, and imitate the mystery you celebrate: Model your life on the mystery of the Lord's cross". This last admonition made to him by the bishop should remain as one of the most precious norms of his Eucharistic ministry.
