## Sacraments

**Marriage:** Six months' notice must be given for marriage, whether here or elsewhere. Please contact the Parish Priest, Fr. Gideon. To make an appointment email: [holloway@rcdow.org.uk](mailto:holloway@rcdow.org.uk).

**Baptism** - Usually happens in the first 6 months after birth. Parents must practice their faith and be registered members of the parish. In order to be invited to the preparation meeting for parents and godparents, all documents must be submitted in advance. If you have a child to be baptised please contact Aileen at [hollowaycat@rcdow.org.uk](mailto:hollowaycat@rcdow.org.uk) or the parish office for more details.

**First Holy Communion & First Reconciliation Programme** There are only a few weeks left to apply on behalf of your child for the program. The deadline to submit the form is **19th October**. The first meeting with parents will be on **Tuesday, 12th November**, and the children's sessions will begin on **Sunday, 17th November**. We anticipate that the children's sessions will take place every Sunday morning during term time only.

**RCIA** The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a journey of faith and an invitation for those who wish to explore the possibility of becoming Roman Catholic. It also serves as a refresher course for those who are already baptised but have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation, such as the Eucharist and Confirmation.
